- 1. The 1<sup>st</sup> IGEM opinion paper: may finalize it as a summary report first, and seeking comments from the participants to see whether we should still submit it as the opinion paper
- The WTDc results have been updated, and we expected to submit WTDc paper in Sep. In the same time, we also expected Chia-Wei and Rong-You to submit poster in AGU fall meeting.
- IPSL has a new postdoc, Toma, they are trying to do the WTDf, which fixed 15% of the WTD in grids, and they will try to compare with the WTD1 and WTD2. This job is only for ORCHIDEE
- 4. How we want to deal with the future SST? Or using the AMIP SST? A Japanese group had a paper in such issue.
- 5. Agnes and Min-Hui will present under ANR-MOST project on Sep. 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> in Taiwan. Currently we are not sure whether this presentation is for public or for scientist. The workshop, current data (3 model outputs), and some results can be the presentation material for now.
- 6. We may also need to prepare for the 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting in 2018. Currently we are going to have it in the first week of November. We should have a list of scientists: not only the participants who came last year, but also potential attendees. We can have some promoting during AGU fall meeting. We also looking forward to have more Asian scientists.
